Zoom, zoom, zoom

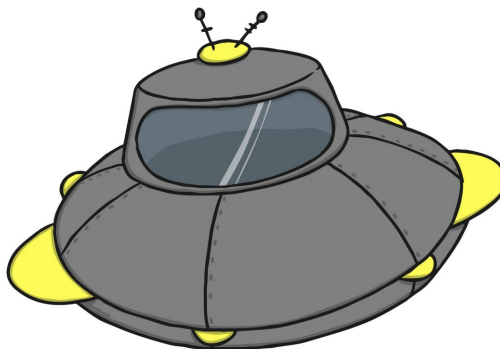
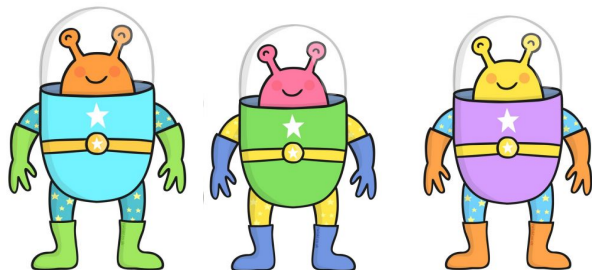
Zoom, zoom, zoom,

Whoosh!

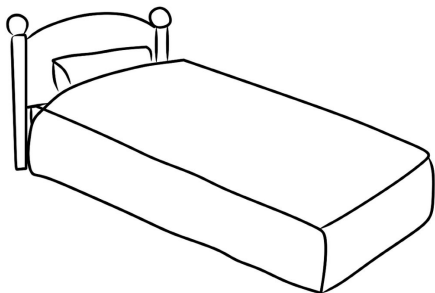
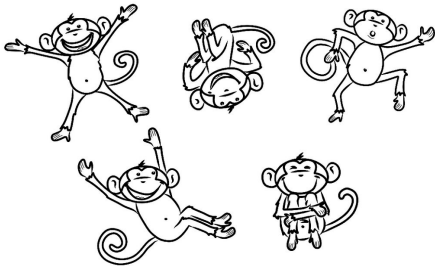
Two little men.....

And only four little ducks came back.

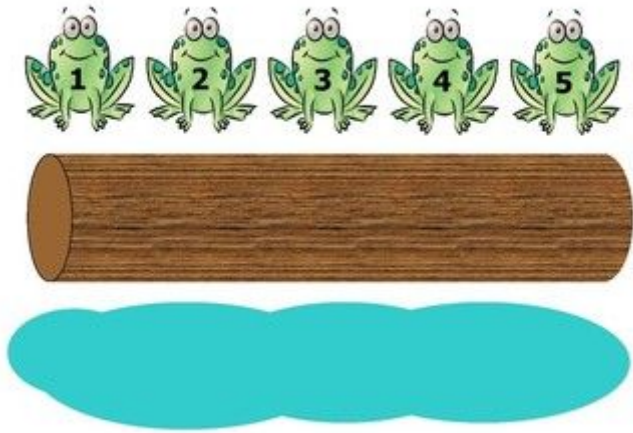

Then there were four green speckled frogs.

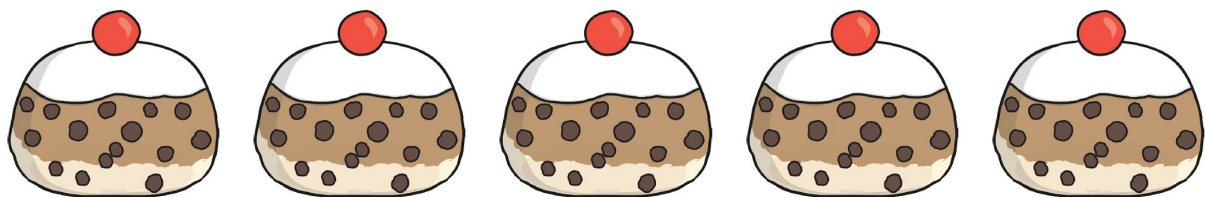

6, 7, 8, 9, 10

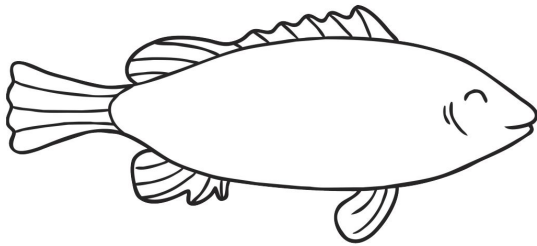
Then I let it go again,

(sing to the tune of "If you're happy and you know it clap your hands")

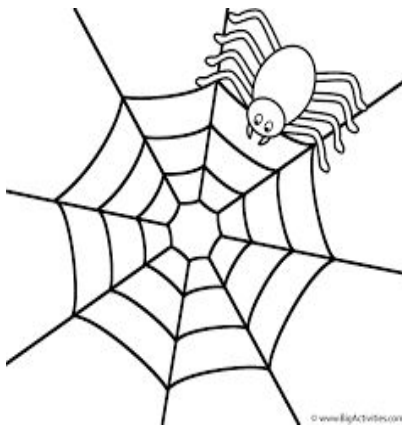

Hello, hello, hello!

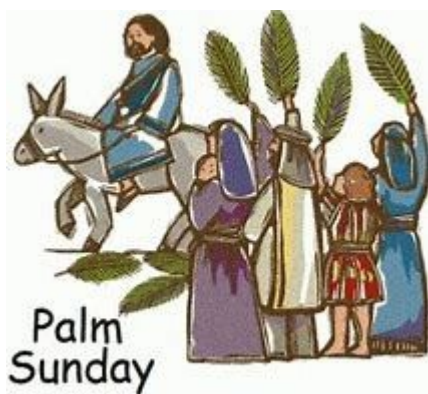


A Song For Easter:
