Religious Education

Judaism: What is it like to live as a Jewish person?
Recognise and talk about the symbols of Judaism. Explain what the Torah is and why it is important.

History

Nursing Heroes: Florence Nightingale. Mary Seacole and Edith Cavell
Study the lives of significant women from the past who have contributed to national and international achievements.
Compare aspects of life in different periods – Crimean War, World War 1 and current day NHS.
Overcoming prejudice (Mary Seacole).

Maths

Measurements: Height and length
Number: Using calculations to solve problems, revisiting mental strategies for addition and subtraction
Fractions: Halves and quarters of shapes and amounts

Physical Education

Team Building: Develop communication and problem-solving skills. Work individually, in pairs and in small groups. Discuss, plan and reflect on ideas and strategies.
Invasion Games: Develop understanding of attacking and defending and what being 'in possession' means. Play uneven and even sided games. Learn how to score points in these types of games and how to play to the rules.
