

English

Year 4 will be using the book 'How to Train Your Dragon' by Cressida Cowell to study the non-fiction genre of instruction writing.

We will also look at Explanation texts linked to our history topic.

Geography

In geography we will continue to explore maps. We will explore the history of maps and also apply our knowledge to draw comparisons to our local area and an area we will soon be visiting (Flatford).

Computing

Year 4 will continue to increase their knowledge of advanced coding skills and vocabulary. They will also be using iPads and other mediums to practice research and presentations skills that.

Personal, Health and Social Education

In PHSE we will be focusing on Health and Wellbeing. Specifically we will do some work on growing and changing covering some puberty changes & reproduction in an age appropriate manner. The children will have the opportunity to this in some separate gender sessions, where the content will be the same.

Science

Pupils will be exploring different materials in Changes and states of matter. They will explore solids, liquids and gasses and how materials transition between the three states.

Religious Education

This term year 4 will be taking a more in depth look at Sikhism. We will be exploring the Big Question – How did the first five Sikh Gurus shape Sikhism? We will explore a different 'Big Question' each week building our vocabulary and subject knowledge.

History

Our history topic this term will build upon the topic of Anglo-Saxons. We will begin to explore Viking invaders and settles, building our vocabulary and knowledge of this time. Children will have the opportunity to explore this exciting topic with cross curricular links to both English and Art.

Maths

Students will explore a variety of topics in summer beginning with decimals and their relationship with fractions and place value. We will also be using the Inspire Maths scheme to begin to learn about angles and parallel and perpendicular lines.

Physical Education

Pupils will take part in a range of skills challenges linked to Football and Cricket; Students must -

Music

Comaneci will continue to learn how to play the Clarinet and Trumpet. Tendulkar will learn how to play the Cello and Violin. Both classes will learn musical notation and how to read music with WICT.
