

English

Berlie Doherty's Street Child will be our core text, with a range of reading and writing activities planned to link in with our History topic. We will be writing diary entries and newspaper reports.

Geography

UK Geography will be our focus, looking at the physical and social geography of the UK, including how laws are made and the function of the UK's infrastructure.

Computing

We will continue with the Purple Mash Computing scheme. Exploring Purple Mash in cross-curricular way - e.g. 2Type (touch typing), 2Publish and 2Publish Plus (writing templates), and using Quiz apps.

Personal, Health and Social Education/SRE

In RSE we will focus on the changes that will occur during puberty, to help prepare the children for this time. There will be the opportunity for separate-gender sessions. We will also do some work on self-esteem related to screen time and consent.

Science

We are going to begin to look at space and the planets. Focusing specifically on the how the Earth, sun and moon move in relation to each other and the effect this has on days/night and shadows.

Religious Education

We will take a deeper dive into Islam, looking at how people show their commitment to their values and religion, relating this our own lives.

History

This half-term our focus will be Victorian education, using St Michael's School as a case study and looking in-depth at the work of Dr Barnado and the socio-economic variation in the Victorian era.

Maths

We will be continuing with the Inspire Maths scheme and utilising various physical resources to ensure mastery. Our main topics will be shape and space.

Physical Education

We will conclude our dodgeball unit, and embark on a unit of gymnastics and a unit of athletics, focusing on a range of different skills and types of physical, individual and team activities.

Music

This term in music, we will be taking as our case study 'Dancin' In The Street' by Martha and the Vandellas (along with other Motown releases), using props and body percussion to experiment with and understand rhythm.

Art / Design and Technology

In art this half term we are going to look at the way artists have used nature to inspire them and their work. We will complete artist studies of Georgia O'Keefe and create earth installations in the style of Andy Goldsworthy.
