In English, we will be:

- Instructional text, identifying key features of instructional texts, learning about imperative verbs and writing instructions.
- Recounts: time connectives, adjectives for description.

In phonics, we will continue to follow the RWI scheme.

Geography

In our seaside topic, the children will develop their geographical vocabulary to describe physical features.

Pupils will be using world maps, atlas and globes to identify countries and oceans.

Computing

We will be following the purple mash scheme. Our focus will be following instructions on a computer program, how to save our own work and understanding how the order of instructions affects the results.

SRE- Relationships, families and people who care for me.

PSHE- Keeping healthy and clean, road safety, making healthy choices.

Science

Our topic for science is plants. Pupils will be able to identify and name a variety of common wild/garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees.

Religious Education

Our unit this term is called: 'Why do Christians make and keep promises before God?' Pupils will learn about Jesus' baptism, explore the idea and meaning of belonging to a church. Pupils will also learn how promises are important in baptism and marriage.

History – King and Queens/ Toys

This term we will continue with our previous topic of king and queen.

We will then move onto our topic of toys. In history we will create timetables of toys, compare old and new toys and appreciate toys in different historical eras.

Maths

We will be focusing on the following topics in maths:

- Numbers to 50 and 100
- Place value
- Fractions
- Time

Physical Education

Athletics: This will link with our fitness unit. Pupils will develop balance whilst jumping and landing; develop balance and rhythm when travelling over obstacles. Pupils will also develop throwing for distance and accuracy.

Fitness: We will be developing skipping skills and 'ABC'- agility, balance and co-ordination.

Music

Pupils will be following the Charanga scheme:

- Composition: creating very simple rhythms and melodies that are notated or recorded in some way.
- Listening and appreciating.
