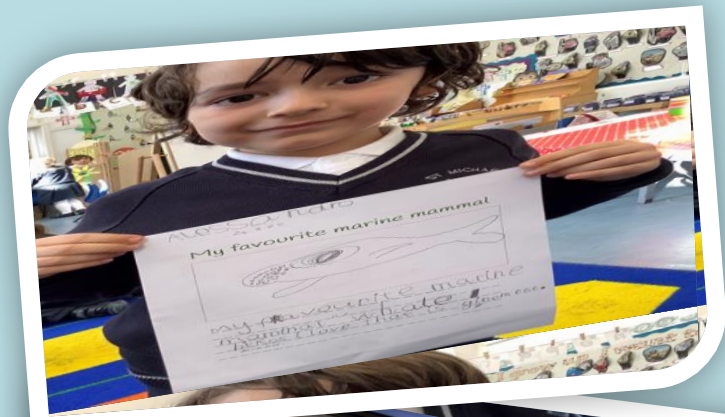
Year 6 Netball

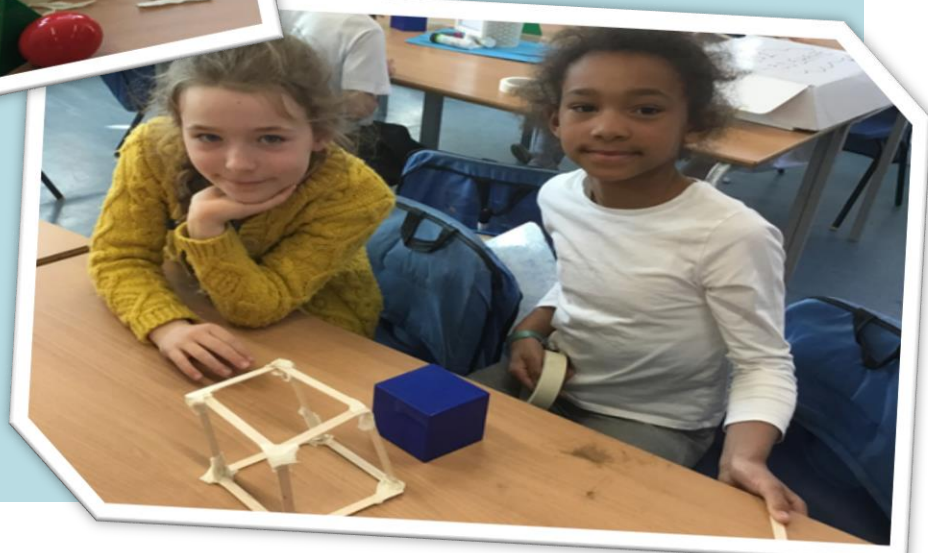


Our theme in nursery is Living Things, and we have been growing cress seeds. Today we harvested the cress and made delicious sandwiches!
