Have a good weekend.

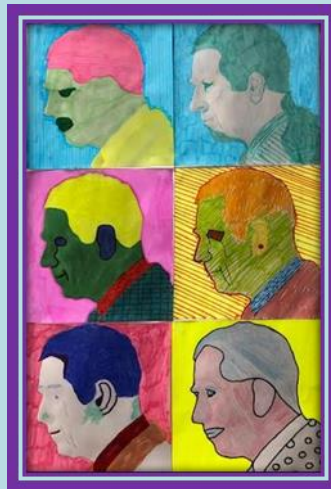

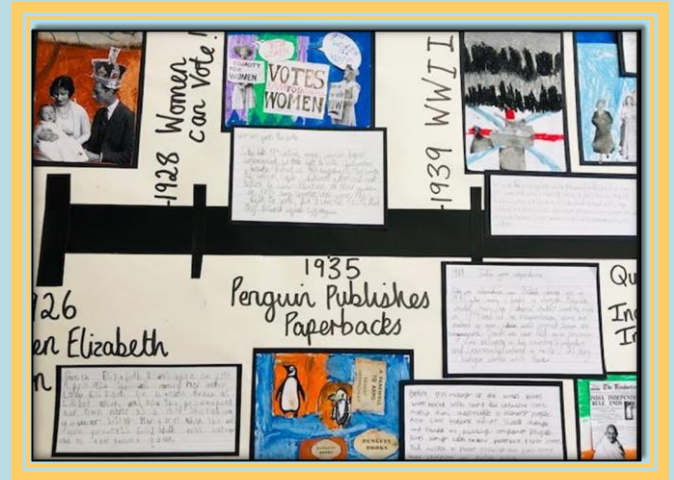

Year 1 Europe were inspired by the work of Andy Warhol to make portraits of Queen Elizabeth II.

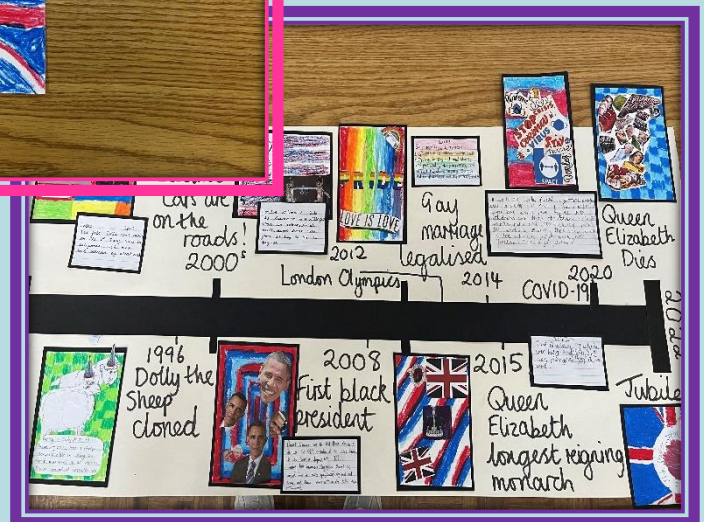
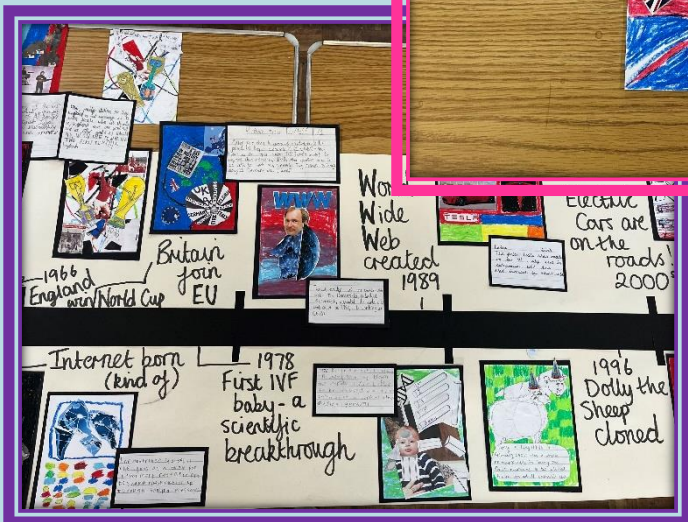
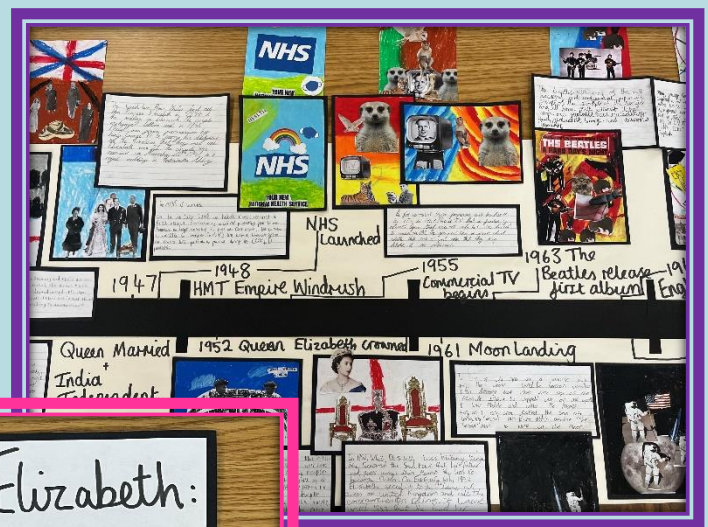


Year 3 have been making commemorative stamps in honour of Queen Elizabeth II. They used their colouring and collage skills and enjoyed adding gold and silver paper to give a touch of royalty to their designs.

Year 4 created a multimedia timeline of events that happened throughout Queen Elizabeth the 2nd's life. Multimedia means the use of two different mediums to create one piece - in this case oil pastels and collage. The children created a simple oil pastel background using a range of technique such as blending, short/long strokes that symbolised their event. After that they collaged images on top and wrote a short piece explaining the event. We then put all our pieces together as one big timeline!! I hope you are as impressed by the amazing events that spanned cross the late Queen Elizabeth's life.
