In school we've all got back into the swing of another new term 2023, and it was so good to see all the children return so happily despite the wind and rain.

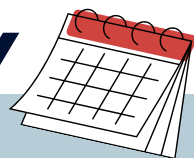

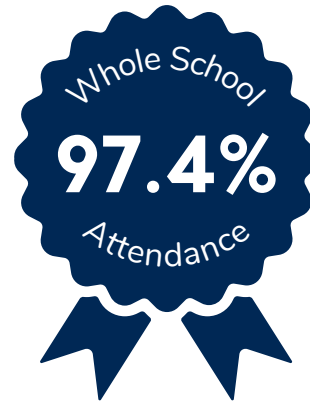

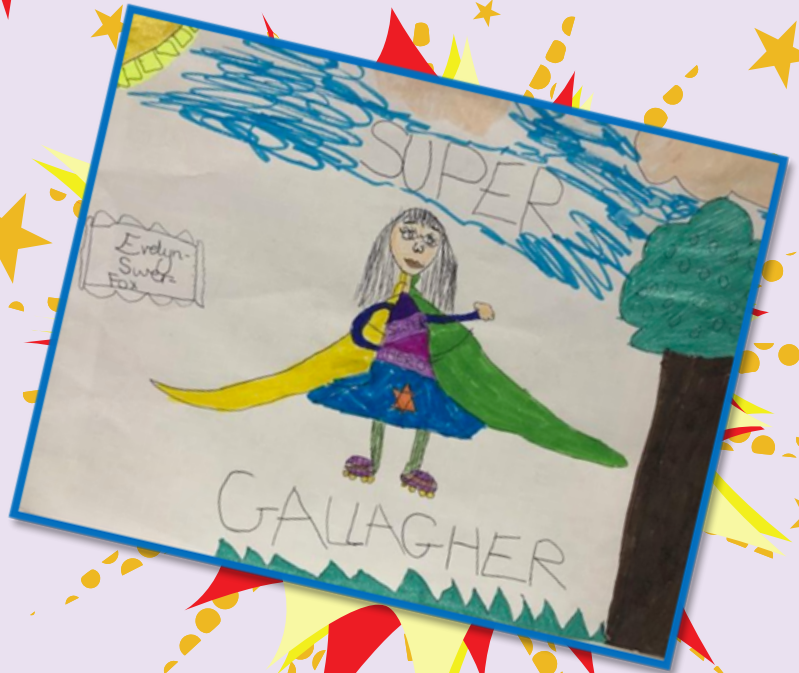
