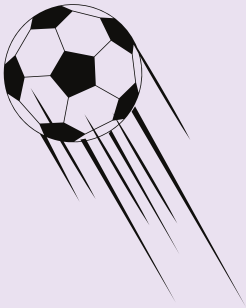
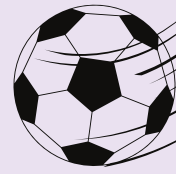
# YEAR 5 LEARNING

Lorenzo: " I played CM (centre mid)"

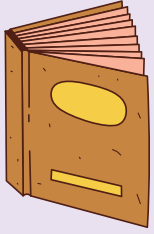

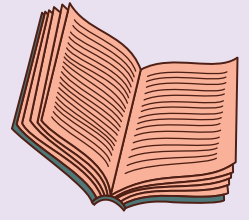

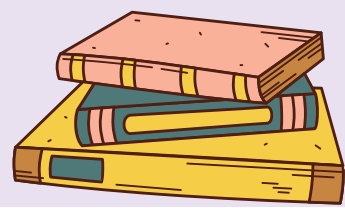




# Reading Raffle WINNERS
