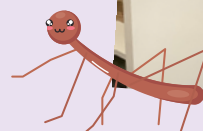
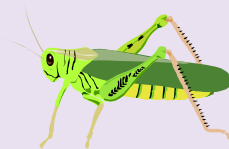
EYFS

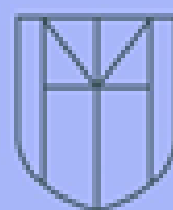

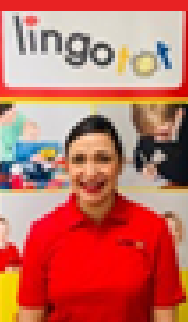

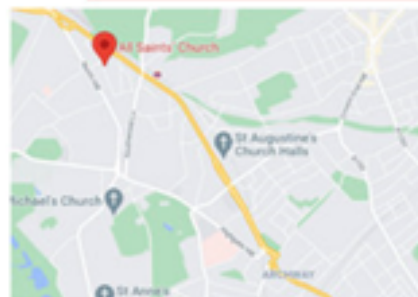
