

SCIENCE TECHNOLOGY ENGINEERING ART MATH

This week we are celebrating STEAM at St Michael's. We would like to thank the parents and volunteers who made this week incredibly special by dedicating their time and sharing their expert knowledge with the students at St Michaels.



We have had experts in the fields of Chemistry, Artificial Intelligence, Architecture, Neurology and Microbiology. In KS2 experts have explained to children how the peace garden was planned and designed, how they can use AI to make drawings and ideas come alive and how the brain works. In KS1 they were taught the differences between acids and alkalis and how to distinguish between complete and incomplete combustion.
