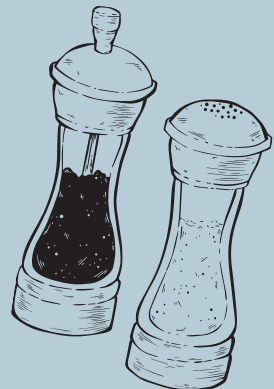
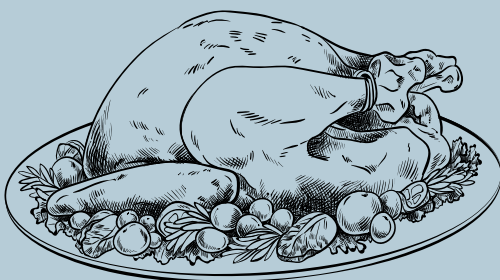
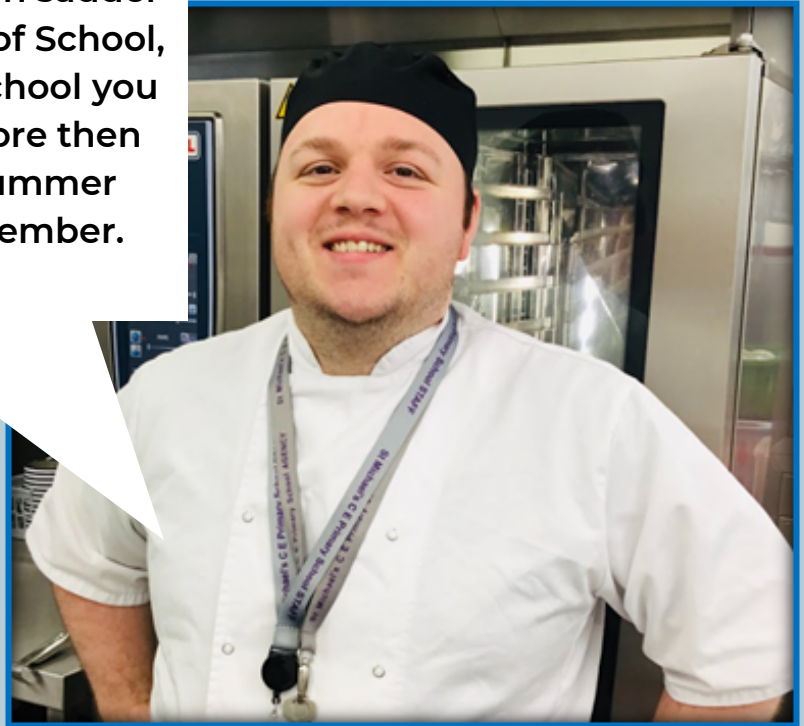




WORD OF THE WEEK

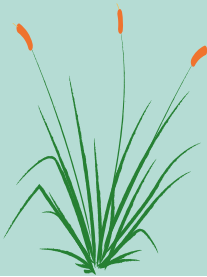
A Year 6 Musical

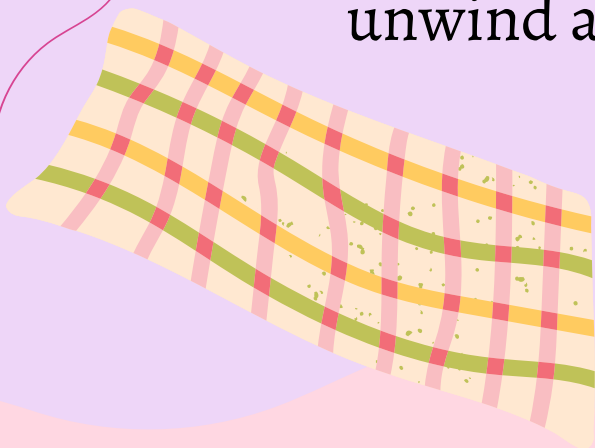




Y1 Europe Class Picnic

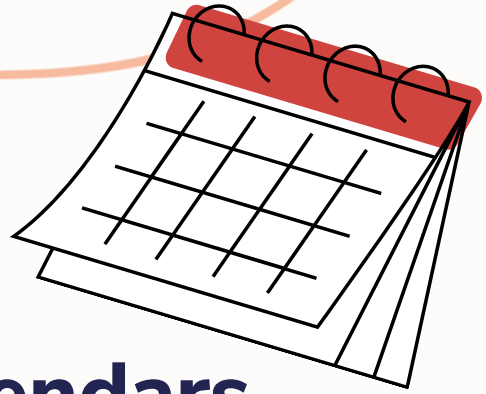
