Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to school and to Year 3! We hope you all had a wonderful and restful summer break. The children have come back so full of enthusiasm for learning and ready for the new routines of Year 3.

General Information

- We have a 'Parent Information Evening' event coming up on **Tuesday 19th September from 5.00 - 5.30 pm**. During this meeting, we will share more information with you about home reading, Google Classroom, homework and sharing homework with teachers. We will also share our curriculum, learning timetable and important calendar dates with you. Slides from this meeting will be saved in Google Classrooms for you to view.
- Soft start - 8.50 am. Along with Years 4, 5 and 6, **from Monday 11th September**, your child can walk to class from the top playground by him/herself. This encourages independence. It also allows the children to do short activities such as Maths challenges, reading or handwriting practice before we take the register.
- The morning register is taken at **8.55 am**. Any children who arrive after this time will be marked as late.
- Pupils have the opportunity to eat a snack from home at break time. This should be a fruit or a vegetable - no nuts. Water bottles should also be brought into school every day.
- Year 3 have their own pegs to keep their belongings safe, but we do ask that jumpers, cardigans and water bottles are labelled in the event they are misplaced during break times.
- Year 3 have their PE lessons on Tuesday and Thursday afternoons. It is best to make sure PE kits are in school every day. They can be taken home over the weekend for washing should you wish. (Please ensure **all PE items are clearly labelled.**)
- It is always best to inform us of changes to pick up arrangements in writing. Please send any changes via the school admin email address admin@stmichaelsn6.com by lunchtime. Alternatively, your child can bring in a note signed by you.

Should you need to contact us for any reason, please get in touch by emailing the school admin address making sure to include your child's name and class. At busier times email responses can take up to 48 hours, but we will always endeavour to respond within the first 24 hours of receipt.
