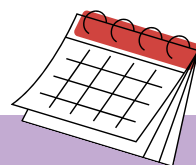

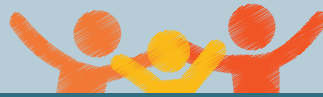

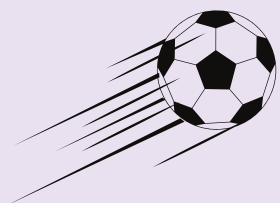
Y6 BOYS FOOTBALL
