St Andrew's Day

St Andrew's day is on 30th November and to celebrate, staff and students alike wore blue or came in traditional Highland dress.

St Andrew is one of the houses the children are put into in KS1 & KS2 for competitions and house points; each is named after of the 4 patron saints of the countries of the UK.







According to the Bible and early Chirstian texts, St Andrew was one of Jesus' Apostles. When St Andrew was martyred by crucifixion in around 60AD, he allegedly deemed himself unworthy to be crucified on the same type of cross as Jesus, and had his cross placed diagonally.

This led to the Saltire (also known as St Andrew's Cross) forming the design of the Scottish flag.

The Christmas spirit is in full swing in Uluru class. Today the children were helping to put the decorations on the tree!






And so it was that a few hours later, Mary gave hirth to her son in that stable. She wrapped Jesus in strips of cloth and laid Him in a manger full of hay.

Santa will be saying ho ho ho to children in the grotto (by pre-bought ticket only).


Please come and have fun and help raise funds for the school.
