Sickness or diarrhoea

If your child has sickness or diarrhoea, they must stay at home for 48 hours after the last bout.

Chicken Pox

We do have cases of chicken pox at the moment. NHS advice is to keep your child at home for 5 days after the first spots appear, or until they crust over.

Bumped Heads

If your child bumps their head during the school day, the Office will call you in the first instance to let you know. If we cannot get hold of anyone, we will send an email and text to notify you.

Most head bumps are very minor, but we will continue to monitor your child throughout the day. If we have any concerns, the Office will call you again.

Appointments

Wherever possible, medical appointments should be made outside of school hours or in the school holidays.

If your child does have an appointment during the school day, they must be collected or dropped off at 12:30pm. This is the designated time in the day we use to minimise disruption to your child's class.

As part of STEAM week, Year 3 has been learning about Wangari Maathai, the founder of the Green Belt movement.

Wangari Maathai initiated the planting of over 30 million trees in Kenya and campaigned against deforestation.

In a tribute to her, we created a forest of trees from recycled materials.

Year 3 also explored the number 30 million. We explored what £30 million could buy Fantasy Football activity and I think we have uncovered some talented future Sporting Directors.

Year 4 made boats out of recycled materials and tested them in a tub of water. The winning boat held 1.3kg of weights.





STEAM Talks

we can do to lower carbon emissions.

He showed us how he traveled on the Sir David Attenborough to Antarctica to look at the impact of climate change on the marine life. Thank you very much for delivering such an informative talk.
