Breakfast Club Cost:

£6 per morning if the booking is made in advance, or £7 if the drop-in service is used. To benefit from the advance rate, please book via [Scopay](https://www.scopay.com) at least a day before the booking is needed. All payments are made via www.scopay.com.

Weather Conditions:

Please note we are running at full capacity; every available space is being used for a club. Any children attending clubs that take place outside should dress appropriately, as we have no room to bring them inside if the weather is bad. If extremely bad weather is forecast, the club will be cancelled and children should be collected at their allocated pick up time if an after-school club, or arrive at school at their allocated school start time for before-school clubs. Please note that clubs cancelled due to bad weather will not be refunded.

Payments:

All clubs must be paid for in full before the club starts or your child will not be registered to attend. Unfortunately, we are unable to refund clubs missed if your child is ill or self-isolating. All clubs booked through Scopay are non-refundable. Clubs booked via Scopay can be paid for using Childcare Vouchers. Monday 15th April: Kes (PG)

Bullied at school and ignored at home by his indifferent mother and older brother, Billy Casper, a 15-year-old working-class Yorkshire boy, tames and trains his pet kestrel falcon whom he names Kes. Helped and encouraged by his English teacher Mr. Farthing and his fellow students, Billy finally finds a positive purpose to his unhappy existence.

Monday 22nd April: Star Wars V - The Empire Strikes Back (PG)

In this movie, the battle to save the galaxy from the evil Darth Vader rages on. Han Solo, Princess Leia, and Chewbacca are tested in a devastating attack by the Imperial army and its AT-AT walkers. Meanwhile, Luke Skywalker seeks out the ancient Yoda to learn the secrets of the Jedi, secrets Luke will need when the Dark Side of the Force beckons him in a destiny-defining duel with Darth Vader.

Monday 29th April: Fly Away Home (U)

Amy is only 13 years old when her mother is killed in a car accident in New Zealand. She goes to Canada to live with her father, Thomas, an eccentric inventor whom she barely knows. She is miserable in her new life...that is until she discovers a nest of goose eggs that were abandoned when developers began tearing up a local forest behind her house. They hatch and she becomes "Mama Goose". They must fly south for the winter, but who will lead them there? With a pair of ultralight airplanes, Amy, Thomas, and their friends must find a way to do so.

Monday 13th May: Ghostbusters (PG)

Three odd-ball scientists get kicked out of their cushy positions at a university in New York City where they studied the occult. They decide to set up shop in an old firehouse and become Ghostbusters, trapping pesky ghosts, spirits, haunts, and poltergeists for money. They wise-crack their way through the city, and stumble upon a gateway to another dimension, one which will release untold evil upon the city. The Ghostbusters are called on to save the Big Apple.

Monday 20th May: Lord of the Rings - The Two Towers (12A) **6:30pm collection******

The Fellowship is torn apart. Sauron's power is growing stronger. While venturing on to Mordor, Frodo and Sam come across the grotesque creature Gollum, who is forever consumed by the Ring's power. Meanwhile, Aragorn, Gandalf, Legolas and Gimli meet up with new allies in the Plains of Rohan. Together, they must work to defend the people of Rohan against Sauron's puppet Saruman as he unleashes his armies from Isengard. All the while, Sauron prepares to launch an attack on Gondor.
